Questions for more in-depth study  
Read through Exodus 5

1. Read Luke 14:26-33. Why does Jesus use such strong and radical language when speaking to the crowd about becoming his disciple? What does this mean to you?
2. Read Matthew 7:24,25. Why would Jesus say this about his teaching? What do you have to do to make this happen in your life?
3. Look at the main challenge. Read Matthew 13:20,21. What distracts you from living in God?
4. Look at main point 1. God has given you the Gospel message. How will you ready yourself to speak that message? What hindrances can you think of?
5. The message Moses spoke was "Let my people go!" Who are we to say that to today?
6. Look at main point 2. Read Ephesians 6:12-16 and John 8:44. How does the enemy fight you and pursue you?
7. How does our culture ridicule the followers of Christ and the church?
8. Look at main point 3. What made the Hebrew leaders go and appeal to Pharaoh? What does this tell us about their source of hope? How does this apply today?
9. Read Exodus 6:9-12. How is this true today for the church? What is the attitude that you are to have? Even though the world may hate, what is your role?
