Questions for more in-depth study

3. Look at the main challenge and look at 1 Kings 12. How does the main challenge fit with this passage? Explain.

5. Reflect on the news of the day. How does it bother you? What do you wish you could do to make it change?
6. Read 1 Kings 14:22-24. Why do you think it said, "Judah did evil" and not Rehoboam?

8. Look at main point 3. As you look at pivotal moments in your life, what would you have done differently? Are you happy with the choices you have made?
