Questions for more in-depth study

Read through Isaiah 2:1-5

1. Read Micah 4:1-3; Isaiah 11:6-9; Zech 9:10; and Hosea 2:18. Compare and contrast these passages with Isaiah 2.
2. Why did Christ come so humbly to earth? Why did he not come to the earth in power, prestige and wealth?
3. Look at the main challenge and read Ephesians 1:9,10. How is Christ able to fulfill what God is directing? How will this come about?
4. Look at the first main point and describe how the temple of the Lord is the presence of God. What is the purpose of the presence of God among humanity?
5. How can we today “stream to God” to seek him? How often do we do this and how easily is it forgotten? Why are people not today “streaming to God”?
6. Look at main point two and read Habakkuk 2:14. What is the knowledge of God? What is the purpose of the knowledge of God?
7. Read Hosea 4:1-6. How is the knowledge of God contrasted with the acts of God’s people?
8. Look at main point three and compare it to John 13:34,35. How is the mountain of the Lord to be demonstrated in the church today? What is your role?
9. Read Acts 2:42-47 and ask God to reveal every area of your heart that is holding onto hurts and grudges. Confess them and ask God to give you a new goal.
