Questions for more in-depth study

Read through Matthew 11: 20 – 24

1. If someone asked you why you believe in Christ what evidence would you use and how would you answer?
2. Read Romans 1:18-20; 2 Peter 3:5; Psalm 19:1-4 and Proverbs 8:1-4. What does scripture teach us about God revealing himself? Why is his revelation so important?
3. Look at the main challenge and read Deut 8:10-18. What is our role in acknowledging God's revelation? How can we acknowledge his revelation in everything we do?
4. Look at main point 1. What gives Christ the right to judge the cities in Galilee? What did these cities do to deserve judgment?
5. Is Christ enough? If you were to experience loss, despair or difficulties are you prepared to say Christ is enough?
6. Look at main point 2. What in this passage is Christ saying about himself? How does it demonstrate that Christ is God in this passage?
7. Reflect on the Truth 2.0 and read Proverbs 9:13-18. How is the voice of folly masquerading as the voice of wisdom?
8. How is what Christ is saying, demonstrating the sin of indifference?
9. How is Christ judging the cities an act of grace and love to the cities? Regardless of people's responses, what is your calling and what must you do?
