Questions for more in-depth study

2. Read Matthew 12:34; 6:21; Ezekiel 36:26. Discuss the importance of the heart and how God views the heart.
3. Look at the main challenge. Describe from this chapter how we are given new eyes, new ears and a new heart. What will this cause us to do and say?
4. Look at main point 1. Discuss the human wisdom and why human wisdom cannot get us to God.
5. When Christ said that the Father has hidden and revealed, what does that mean? What does it mean to be child-like versus childish?
6. Look at main point 2. Read carefully 11:27. What is significant that Jesus is saying here?
