Questions for more in-depth study  
Read through Psalm 24

1. The blood of Christ does not lose its power. How is this important to you? How will you live differently?
2. The blood of Christ is greater than your sin. What shame and sin do you still hold onto?
3. Look at the main challenge and read Psalm 24:1,2. How are these verses related to who Christ is? What does this say about God generally and specifically?
4. Look over main point 1 and observation 1. Since God is creator what does that mean for every person? What does that mean to you?
5. Look at main point 2 and read Psalm 24:3-6 and Psalm 15. What is significant with what these Psalms are saying and the truth of Ps 24:1,2? How are they related?
6. How is your heart in relation to what Christ is expecting? How does this demonstrate holiness and authority?
7. Look at main point 3. Since Christ is creator and holy what is the obvious choice when he wants to come in? What happens when a sinner asks Christ to come in?
8. Reflect on Psalm 24:7-10 and read it in light of Mark 11.
9. Read Psalm 24:3,4 in light of Romans 6. What is God expecting of you? What will you do to develop a lifestyle of holiness?
