4. Look at main point 1. What is significant in Habakkuk that God tells him to write what he says on a tablet?
5. Read Jeremiah 31:33. How is what is written on our hearts an affirmation of God's love? How does what is written affect what we read in Habakkuk 2:4?
6. Look at main point 2. Knowing that God controls the future how does that help you in planning for the future?
