5. Read Jude 1. How is being loved and kept by Christ significant in understanding value?
6. If the church is valuable to Christ, then what would you expect the enemy to do? How would you expect him to act?
7. Read through Jude 5-16. Define the attitude and plan of the false teacher. What are at least three characteristics of the false teacher?
8. Read through Jude 17-23. How do you aggressively act in living for Christ?
9. Read the doxology (Jude 24,25). How is what Jude is writing a call to act?
