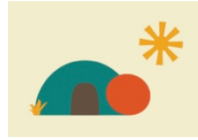

Questions for more in-depth study

Read through Philippians 2:5-11

1. What does the resurrection of Christ mean to you? What does the resurrection say about Christ?
2. What does this mean: "All that we need to know about who we are and all that we need to know about God is found in Christ"? How is Christ the substance and reality of what it means to be human?
3. Look at the main challenge. How is the main challenge described and related to the Philippian passage?
4. Look at main point 1. How does Paul describe this in the Philippian passage? How does this truth describe the significance of what Paul is writing?
5. In Philippians 2:7, what does it mean that Jesus emptied himself? What are we called to empty of ourselves?
6. Look at main point 2. How is who Christ is in this passage a description of our calling when we follow him?
7. Read Matthew 16:24-26 and Matthew 5:38-42. How are these passages related and how do they relate to the Philippian passage?
8. Look at main point 3. How is the experience of Christ connected to Abraham when asked to give up his son? How did Christ gain glory compared to how we seek it?
9. What does knowing Christ has risen say about Christ and about you? What does knowing "Christ is risen" compel us to do?
