Questions for more in-depth study

1. Read Luke 19:1-10. How is this Christ event a description of Christ's heart, attitude and will? How does this event reveal the heart of God?
2. Reflect on the conversations Jesus had with people in the Gospels? Whom did he spend time with? What conclusions can you make on this?
3. Look at the main challenge. How have you been healed by Christ? How do you bring healing to others?
4. Look at main point 1. How did Jesus seek out the hurting? How does he give meaning to the hurting?
5. What should our response be in knowing we have one more move in Christ? What does that mean?
