4. Look at main point 1. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:16. What does the command mean in light of how Christ saw the crowd?
5. When you are hurting and struggling do you feel like ministering? Explain. How is Christ able to minister to the crowd? What is his goal in helping the crowd?
6. What is significant of Jesus getting out of the boat? How was his compassion an expression of his grieving?
7. Look at main point 2. What are significant ways we can act like Christ and do what Christ has merely done for us?
